## CASE REPORT C17 : GRADE 2 BURN INJURY ON THE **RIGHT HAND**

## Background and objective

Male aged 70 years with hypertension and atrial fibrillation. The patient got a grade 2 burn injury of the right dominant hand caused by hot, boiling water (Figure 1 and 2).

## Procedure

Local treatment with Abilar 5% Resin Ointment was initiated immediately. The ointment was applied once a day. Systemic antimicrobial therapy was not administered.

# **Results**

After two weeks of treatment with Abilar 5% Resin Ointment the burn injury was completely healed. No other treatment options were needed.

## Conclusions

Due to antimicrobial and anti-inflammatory action of Abilar 5% Resin Ointment, no clinical or laboratory signs of infection or inflammation were observed. Enhancement of epithelialisation is cleary visible during the treatment.
